Current testing for toxicity is limited to every 3 years and only to less than 50% of the faucets in the building are tested, furthermore they test the same faucets each test. The School water has routinely been smelly, brown, dirty and to date less than 30% of the faucets in the school are "consumable" drinking water per Dep of Health. This is unacceptable. Per Regulation HR270. To be direct about this we have approached the BOE, Pittman, Principal Harris and Dep of Education Brian Wells. This has carried on for more than two years and we as parents are not happy. We want answers and will continue to gather extensive details about this. My Daughter routinely comes home from school saying her teachers won't let them fill up their water bottles or use the faucets unless they use the special water fountain that is determined to be clean. The school staff cook and wash their hands in water that has never been tested. This is wholly unacceptable. .
