Some companies now require deposits a year in advance, and all due monies to be paid 60 days in advance of a trip.

Lincoln's Funeral Train Trail & Scenic Tractor-Pulled Wagon Ride

Elizabethtown, PA

Take a trip on the Harrisburg, Lincoln & Lancaster Railroad which will take you back to a time when the steam locomotive ruled the rails. We will ride behind an 1868 replica of a 4-4-0 steam locomotive as it huffs, chugs, whistles, hoots, and rings its bell, traversing the original 1838 railroad bed on which President Lincoln's funeral train traveled on in April of 1865. You will travel round trip in an 1848 Pioneer Coach or a mid-1860's Combine Car that will make its way along the rails, passing an original 1835 hand-cut and stacked stone wall, through woodlands with 250 to 350-year-old "witness" trees, that were there when the original funeral train passed through, past the restored 1844 Herr's Mill Covered Bridge, and along Conoy Creek. A station stop at the restored 1844 Herr's Mill Covered Bridge provides breathtaking views and photo ops of both the covered bridge as well as the cascading, boulder-lined Conoy Creek. The train continues to the end of the line where it will pull into a 235-foot-long, replica of a typical 1860's-style Engine House where guests will disembark to enjoy a tour of the all-new Lincoln Funeral Train Museum and a narrated walk-through of the only ever built replica of the Lincoln Funeral Car, the "United States." The funeral car is not handicap accessible. The "United States" rail car is a 2015 replica of the first private rail car originally built for President Lincoln in 1865. A boxed lunch is included. Please provide a meal choice when making your reservations. Your choices are Ham Wrap, Turkey Wrap, or Veggie Wrap. Following lunch, enjoy a scenic tractor-pulled wagon ride around the grounds of the estate. Keep a watchful eve out for long-horn steers, horses, and the native wildlife including deer, turkey, rabbits, fix, and birds of all kinds.

Anne Arundel County Senior Activity Center Trip Rules

- All trips are open to Senior Center members. Current key tags must be shown when registering for a trip.
- Participants must be self-sufficient to go on trips. Senior Center Manager may require physician's certification to approve travel.
- Anyone who exhibits inappropriate behavior must be approved by the Senior Center Manager before traveling.
- Registration will commence upon receipt of the required deposit. Checks are preferred.
- All monies are non-refundable unless a replacement can be found from the waiting list. Certified exceptions will be handled on a case by case basis by Trip Leader and/or Senior Center staff.
- Participants must furnish their own transportation to and from meeting points.
- Buses will not wait for anyone. Participants must adhere to scheduled arrival & departure times. Should
 you become disconnected from the group while on a trip, call your Senior Center.
- Trip participants should carry an index card with their name, address, and emergency contact.
- Absolutely no smoking or alcoholic beverages on the buses.
- Participants should: (1) Avoid contaminating others on trip by staying home when suffering from
 communicable illnesses (e.g., flu, colds, etc.) (2) Avoid causing allergic or other adverse reactions by not
 using strong or excessive fragrances. (3) Be flexible. Under special circumstances, be prepared to
 accommodate room and seatmates as assigned.
