All refund requests must be made in writing to the Child Care Administrative Office.

- AGES: Children MUST be entering 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade for the 2024-2025 school year to be eligible to attend Summer SACC.
- **STATE MANDATED FORMS:** Every child MUST have the State mandated forms completed and on file at the site prior to their first day of attending. **No one will be permitted to attend without this information on file. Health Inventory requires a physician's signature.**
