

## Indemnity Waiver

I desire to participate in the activities of the Anne Arundel County Police 5K Fun Run and Walk under the supervision of agents or employees for Anne Arundel County, Maryland ("the County").

In consideration of being permitted to participate in such activities, I agree to release and discharge the County, its agents, employees and volunteers, from all claims, causes of action, and liability for any injuries and/or damages sustained by me resulting in any way from participation in this event. I understand that I am assuming any and all risk of injury or other harm from participation in the Anne Arundel County Police Department and the County does not assume any responsibility or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance for such injury or harm. This release and waiver extends to other individuals participating in the activities and includes aggravation of any preexisting injury or condition.

I understand that my participation in the activities may be disclosed to other County or State agencies or the public. I give permission for video recordings or photographs to be taken of me during the activities and consent to their publication or broadcast for any purpose without further compensation to me.

I understand that my participation is voluntary and, at any time, I can decline to participate in any or all activities. I agree to abide by all safety instructions and information provided to me and to comply with the directions of the agents for the County. Further, I understand that the County may decline to allow me to participate in some or terminate my participation in all of these activities for any or no reason.

If the Participant is under eighteen (18) years old, the Parent or Guardian must also agree to the following:

As Parent/Guardian of the Participant, a minor, I give permission for his/her participation in such activities. On behalf of the minor, I agree to the General Release and Waiver and that every waiver, hold harmless and consent stated herein applies to him/her to the same extent as it would apply to an adult.
