## How to Navigate the Map on the Anne Arundel County WaterSIP Customer Service Line Material Self Reporting Survey

Step 1. Once you click a link to the survey, a box will appear with an introduction and disclaimer text. Read through the information, check the box, and click “continue.”

Anne Arundel County is asking customers with unknown service line materials to submit information using this survey. Your responses will be used for the sole purpose of verifying water service line material as required by the [U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Safe Drinking Water Act, 2021 Lead and Copper Rule Revision](#).

A service line is the water pipe that connects your home to the public water main. The service line carries water from the main to the faucets, toilets, and other fixtures within your house and can typically be seen where it enters your home in the basement or crawlspace.

To complete this short 5-minute survey, please have the following available:

- Magnet
- Penny or a key
- Smart phone or digital camera
- Internet access to upload information




Step 3. To ensure that you are looking at the correct area, please verify the labels of the cross streets.




Step 4. Next, zoom into the identified area by selecting the “+” symbol.




Step 5. Identify your residence by selecting the icon labelled with your address number. A blue dot indicates that a survey should be submitted, and a green triangle indicates that a survey does not need to be submitted.




Step 6. Once you click the blue dot or green triangle, a box will appear with your address. Blue dots will have a clickable link that says, "Complete the survey now." Green triangles do not require a survey to be completed and has no link.
