RESOLUTION: PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY TO: PERMIT THE COUNTY COUNCIL TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM VALUE OF PURCHASES AND CONTRACTS SUBJECT TO A SIMPLIFIED COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT PROCESS FROM GREATER THAN \$5,000 TO GREATER THAN \$10,000; AND INCREASE THE MINIMUM VALUE OF PURCHASES THAT ARE REQUIRED TO BE PUBLISHED ON THE COUNTY WEBSITE FROM \$5,000 OR GREATER TO GREATER THAN \$10,000

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

The purpose of this resolution is to amend the Charter of Anne Arundel County to: permit the County Council to increase the minimum value of purchases and contracts subject to a simplified competitive procurement process from greater than \$5,000 to greater than \$10,000; and increase the minimum value of purchases that are required to be published on the County website from \$5,000 or greater to greater than \$10,000.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to place this charter amendment on the ballot. If enacted, this charter amendment would be a procedural change to the purchasing process, with no anticipated fiscal impact. Based on current data, the change is expected to impact less than 0.54% of transactions.
