5 reinspection, and renewal fees collected by the Department of Inspections and Permits;
6 modifying the limit on refunds related to certain unissued permits; modifying the
7 penalty for occupancy without a certificate of occupancy; ~~providing for automatic~~
8 ~~adjustment of certain fees under the Construction Code and of grading permit fees;~~
9 making certain technical and stylistic changes; providing for the effective date; and

24 permit expiration, and if the Department finds that a hardship exists, the times set forth in
25 section 105.5 may be extended for up to one additional year from the date of expiration. A
26 permit that is extended is subject to a ~~[[~~[\$25.00]] \$50 fee. A renewed permit may not be
27 extended.

30 six months after permit expiration, and if the Department finds that a hardship exists, an
31 expired permit may be renewed for up to one additional year from the date of expiration.

12 plumbing systems or alterations requiring a permit, a fee for each permit shall be paid as
13 required, in accordance with the schedule as established by the applicable governing
14 authority. A ~~[[\\$25.00 dollar]]~~ \$43 nonrefundable permit application fee will be assessed for
15 all permits.

20 **108.2.1.4 Investigation fees.** Whenever work for which a permit or application for
21 inspection is required under the Construction Code has been commenced without issuance
22 of a permit or request for inspection, an investigation shall be made before a permit or
23 request for inspection may be issued for the work. In addition to the regular permit fee, an
24 investigation fee of ~~[[\\$40]]~~ \$150 shall be collected. The payment of the investigation fee
25 may not exempt a person from compliance with the provisions of the Construction Code
26 or from any penalty prescribed by law.

28 **108.2.2.1 Application Fee.** A ~~[[\\$25.00]]~~ \$43 nonrefundable application fee shall be
29 assessed for all soil percolation tests.

31 **108.2.3 Electrical permit fees.** The fees set forth in section 108.2.3 shall be paid to the

33 total permit fee calculated for additions, alterations, or repairs to existing structures or

108.2.4 Fuel gas permit fees. A gasfitting permit fee for gas fuel-burning equipment shall be paid to the County according to the pipe size as follows:

A gasfitting permit fee is based on the size of the gas pipe leading from the gas meter in the building, the service gas pipe entering a building, or the gas pipe leading from an existing gas service pipe inside of a building. The gasfitting permit fee based on the size of the pipe supplying the system shall cover, without additional cost, one or more gas burning appliances supplied with gas from the pipe. An inspection fee of [[\\$100]] \$173 or [[\\$20]] \$34 per unit, whichever is greater, shall be paid to the County for onsite gas installations.

108.2.5 Mechanical permit fees. A permit fee for residential uses including one- and two-family and multifamily dwellings shall be paid to the County as follows:

38 sewer only is ~~[[\$95]]~~ \$164, and for both onsite water and sewer is ~~[[\$190]]~~ \$328.

40 **108.2.8 Public water and sewer connection fees.** For public water connection,

42 user or capital connection charges associated with water and sewer permits required by
43 Article 13 of the County Code prior to the issuance of permits.

45 **108.4.1 Refund for unissued permit.** Prior to building permit issuance, a 50% refund
46 may be issued. ~~[[The maximum amount retained by the County may not exceed \$1,000.]]~~
47 PERMIT APPLICATION FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE.

1 **108.5.1 Transfer of electrical, plumbing, mechanical, and fuel gas permits.** A fee
2 of ~~[[\\$25]]~~ \$43 shall be paid to the County for transfer of a trade electrical, plumbing,
3 mechanical, or fuel gas permit. A person licensed under Article 11 of the County Code may
4 not apply for an electrical, plumbing, mechanical, or fuel gas permit or commence work
5 for which another person licensed under Article 11 was issued a permit unless the original
6 licensee has withdrawn or been removed from the work and has notified the Department
7 in writing. Letters of explanation from the person for whom the work is to be performed or
8 from either or both licensees shall be sent to the Code Official explaining the
9 circumstances. If an electrical, plumbing, mechanical, or fuel gas contractor who signed an
10 application for an electrical, plumbing, mechanical, or fuel gas permit dies, the permit shall
11 be held in abeyance from the date of death. The extent of the work satisfactorily completed
12 by the deceased shall be recorded on the Inspector's record and on the permit. If the owner
13 decides to have the remainder of the work done, the original permit shall be reactivated on
14 written request of the owner. The electrical, plumbing, mechanical, or fuel gas contractor
15 who is to complete the work shall sign the original electrical, plumbing, mechanical, or
16 fuel gas application on file at the Department and shall be held responsible for the work
17 completed.

26 WHICH IS NOT ACCESSIBLE TO THE INSPECTOR.
