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(s) **Development applications submitted prior to June 1, 2019.** For a property for which an application for approval of a building permit, sketch plan, final plan, preliminary plan, or site development plan was submitted to the Office of Planning and Zoning prior to June 1, 2019, or for which an allocation was granted prior to June 1, 2019, the capital facility connection charge shall be \$7,202 for connections to the County's water system and \$7,202 for connections to the County's wastewater system. The rates in this subsection shall increase by 2.5% on July 1 of each year [[beginning in]] FROM 2020 [[and]] through 2022 AND BEGINNING IN 2024.

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SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
