A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Subdivision and Development – Adequate School
2 Facilities – School Utilization Chart

3
4 FOR the purpose of approving the “School Utilization Chart, 2024 – Revised” prepared by
5 the Planning and Zoning Officer.

7 WHEREAS, Section 17-5-502(a) of the County Code provides that the Planning
8 and Zoning Officer shall prepare a school utilization chart no later than March 1
9 each year for the approval by ordinance of the County Council; and

11 WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Officer prepared a school utilization chart
12 entitled “School Utilization Chart, 2024”, based on information supplied by the
13 Board of Education as to State-rated capacity for each public school, actual
14 enrollment for each public school for the 2023-2024 school year as of
15 February 1, 2024, and the other requirements of § 17-5-502 of the County Code;

18 WHEREAS, the “School Utilization Chart, 2024” was approved by the County
19 Council by Bill No. 22-24; and

21 WHEREAS, additional enrollment and other information for the 2023-2024 school
22 year has projections have become available in the 2024 Educational Facilities
23 Master Plan (“EFMP”) indicating a significant change in capacities, and the
24 Planning and Zoning Officer has used this additional information to prepare a new
25 school utilization chart entitled “School Utilization Chart, 2024 – Revised”; now
26 therefore

1 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
2 That the “School Utilization Chart, 2024 – Revised”, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is
3 hereby approved and shall take effect on the date this Ordinance takes effect.

5 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
6 from the date it becomes law.
