- November 8th at 9:00 AM;
- November 12th at 9:00 AM;
- November 13th at 10:00 AM;
- November 14th at 9:00 AM; and
- November 15th at 10:00 AM.

All canvasses in Anne Arundel County will be held at the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections, 6740 Baymeadow Drive, Glen Burnie and are open to the public. As of October 13th, the Board of Elections has sent 81,552 mail-in ballots and has received 32,405 back from voters.
