This summary was prepared by the Anne Arundel County Government Relations Office for use by members of the Anne Arundel County Council during consideration of Bill No. 27-25.

Summary

This Bill, submitted by the Budget Office at the request of the Indian Hills Community Association, Inc., which administers the Indian Hills Special Community Benefits District ("SCBD"), places a multi-year obligation for the Indian Hills Special Community Benefit District on public record. The loan from First Citizen's Bank is in the amount of one hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$190,000.00), and will be repaid with the special taxes assessed to property owners in the SCBD. It is for the purpose of improving community owned property, specifically the community playground, and has a term of 69 months. The loan offer letter, terms and conditions, meeting minutes where the loan was approved, and construction estimate for the playground, have all been provided to the Council.

Purpose

This Bill places a multi-year loan obligation for the Indian Hills Special Community Benefit District on public record and will be repaid with the SCBD special taxes.
