1. Report out from Pumphrey:
  - a. There was low attendance at the last meeting, but the next meeting will be in person
  - b. Beginning to work with On the Move Homeless Outreach to support the community
  - c. There are ongoing environmental issues with the Belle Grove corporation
    - i. There are new owners and the county had the intent to acquire the property but that has not happened yet
    - ii. There are going to be community hearings about the area
    - iii. Residents are in favor of having the area rezoned as residential
    - iv. The Pumphrey community has asked for testing reports from Belle Grove corporation but the tests are behind schedule
  - d. The Chesapeake Bay Foundation is giving grants to organizations in Northern Anne Arundel and Curtis Bay
2. Youth Subcommittee:
  - a. The first meeting was introductory for the youth to the ENOUGH Act and what they will be doing
  - b. The youth from Pumphrey were well represented
  - c. The Partnership will begin planning the next meeting with partners
3. Material Review
  - a. Dr. Ashworth will send the data from the Brooklyn Park day
    - i. Respondents shared multiple areas for things they would like to see in Brooklyn Park including: Security & patrolling, more police, more clinics, drug assistance programs, alcohol services, food & bill assistance, police on bikes, pest control, waste management, activities for youth, speed bumps, traffic controls, community cohesion, job opportunities, fundraisers, housing assistance, free childcare and health care
    - ii. The Health Department has done [pest control](#) programming and continues to offer services to Brooklyn Park
4. Asset map review
  - a. Leadership team reviewed asset map the Partnership has created to begin understanding the assets and where there are gaps
  - b. Map will be sent to leadership team
5. General Discussion:



- a. Community associations have begun to meet together and form a community alliance
  - b. Delegate Simmons requested over \$500k in bonds but only received \$20k
  - c. Brooklyn Park has the highest need but gets the lowest amount of money
  - d. It is important to make sure we are going after grants and bringing resources to the community
  - e. Delegate Simmons will share his list of bond proposals
  - f. Bike patrols will begin next month in the northern district. There has been a push from the community for this.
  - g. There is an additional focus on drunk driving and automobile fatalities, vaping (the Health Department [shared their resources](#)), and reaching out to owners to maintain rental properties
  - h. There is a push for license plate readers and shot fire spotters in the community
  - i. Theft and property crime is high
    - i. Residents are reporting their issues on social media rather than with the police
    - ii. The shopping centers on Richie Highway have allowed for police department to have access if they are called
    - iii. Recently an incident with offensive graffiti
  - j. Brooklyn Park Community Day
    - i. Will have another planning meeting
  - k. Community schools will be hosting summer activities for kids
    - i. Belle Grove will have a basketball clinic
    - ii. Rec and Parks will also do programming and have filled 26 of 30 slots
  - l. Would like to have the involvement of Rec and Parks
    - i. Delegate Simmons will facilitate having someone involved
  - m. Zip code
    - i. Delegate Simmons' office is waiting for the guidelines and language needed to file the complaint for changing the zip code
    - ii. Residents have had many issues with sharing the zip code with Baltimore City
    - iii. A community meeting will need to be held
