## THE "ACT" IN ACTION:

Fair Housing in Anne Arundel County

The Office of Equity & Human Rights and Arundel Community Development Services partnered with the Equal Rights Center to test the <u>rental housing market</u> in Anne Arundel County for housing discrimination. Tests focused on disability, race, source of income, and national origin.

From March 2023 to February 2024, the Equal Rights Center conducted 70 tests, of 65 properties, managed by 53 housing providers across the County. Here is what they found.
