




# **Facility Layout**

- Splash Pad Deck will abut the Existing Patio, accessed from the indoor recreation pool.
- New gates will be provided to meet emergency egress requirements.
  Gates will NOT be used as entrances.
- The Pump House is located to the north. The pump house exterior design is intended to reflect that of the existing facility.
- **1** The fencing will be black, prefinished aluminum 3-rail, picket fence, 8' tall
- 2 The cantilevered shade structure will be 8' tall x 8' deep x 40' long
- 3 (12) 6' long, fixed benches & (3) fixed trash receptacles will be provided around the Splash Pad Deck perimeter
- 4 New stairs provide a secondary route to the existing parking lot. These stairs will not require handrails or guardrails
- (2) ADA-compliant, wall-mount rinse showers will be provided on Pump House.





# Components



8 feet tall, Black, Prefinished Aluminum, 3-rail Picket Fencing





- **3** (12) 6' long, fixed benches shall be provided around the Splash Pad Deck perimeter

 2 8' tall x 8' deep x 40' long Cantilevered Shade Structure. (proposed structure does not include masonry base)



5 (2) wall-mount rinse showers shall be provided on Pump House.


