### Resolution No. 13-25

## Introduced by Mr. Smith

# By the County Council, April 21, 2025

1	RESOLUTION designating May 10, 2025 as National Pan-Hellenic Council Day in
2	Anne Arundel County to recognize the contributions made to social change by members
3	of the nine Black sororities and fraternities, known as the Divine Nine
4	
5	WHEREAS, The National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC) is the coordinating body
6	of Black Greek-Letter Organizations of college-educated women and men
7	committed to "community awareness and action through educational, economic,
8	and cultural service activities"; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, the NPHC was founded on May 10, 1930, at Howard University by
11	five chartering organizations: Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Delta Sigma Theta
12	Sorority, Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, and Omega Psi Phi
13	Fraternity; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, the NPHC then added four more organizations to its membership:
16	Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity and Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity in 1931, Sigma Gamma
17	Rho Sorority in 1937, and Iota Phi Theta Fraternity in 1997 – later becoming known
18	affectionately as the "Divine Nine"; and

20	WHEREAS, under the powerful motto "Until We Are All Free", the NPHC
21	sororities and fraternities work together to create social programs that bring about
22	the social change that their members want to see for themselves, for their peers, for
23	Blacks across the nation, and for the nation itself; and

25	Whereas, The designation of a day is fitting to commemorate the founding of the
26	NPHC and the community work that is done by Divine Nine members in Anne
27	Arundel County and in communities across the nation; now, therefore, be it

29	Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it designates
