## A BILL ENTITLED

1	AN ORDINANCE concerning: County Executive – Compensation
2	
3	FOR the purpose of setting the rate of compensation for the County Executive.
4	
5	WHEREAS, Section 406 of the Charter empowers the County Council, by an
6	affirmative vote of not less than five of its members, to alter the compensation of
7	the County Executive, except for the incumbent County Executive during their
8	current term; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, the salary of the County Executive was most recently set by the
11	County Council in 2014 in Bill No. 53-14, and is currently \$142,000 per year; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, the Anne Arundel County Personnel Board has submitted a report to
14	the County Council recommending an increase in salary of the County Executive,
15	taking into account the salaries and other compensation of County Executives in
16	neighboring jurisdictions of similar size; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, the County Council has reviewed the Personnel Board report and other
19	relevant information; now, therefore,
20	
21	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
22	That, under the provision of Section 406 of the Charter, the annual salary for the position
23	of County Executive is hereby established as follows:
