A BILL ENTITLED

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget - Board of 1 Education – Supplementary Appropriation and Transfers of Funds 2 3 FOR the purpose of transferring appropriations of funds between certain offices, 4 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies in the general fund; 5 making supplementary appropriations from unanticipated revenues to the School 6 Current Expense Fund for the current fiscal year; making this ordinance an emergency 7 measure; and generally relating to transferring and reducing appropriations of funds 8 and supplementary appropriations of funds in the current expense budget for the fiscal 9 year ending June 30, 2025. 10 11 12 BY amending: Current Expense Budget 13 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, the County Executive may 14 authorize transfers of funds within the same department and within the same fund; 15 16 and 17 18 WHEREAS, under Section 711(a) of the Charter, upon recommendation of the County Executive, the County Council may transfer funds between offices, 19 departments, institutions, boards, commissions or other agencies of the County 20 government and within the same fund of the Current Expense Budget; and 21 22 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the 23 County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations 24 from revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates 25 and from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the 26

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current fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such 1 funds are available for appropriation; and 2 3 WHEREAS, § 5-105(a) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of 4 Maryland, requires that all revenues received by the Board of Education be spent 5 6 in accordance with the major categories of its annual budget as provided under § 5-101 of the Education Article, and § 5-105(b) of the Education Article requires 7 that transfers between major categories be approved by the County Council; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended the transfer and 10 supplementary appropriation of certain funds, and the Controller has certified in 11 12 writing that such funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore, 13 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, 14 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, be and it is 15 hereby amended by making supplementary appropriations of revenues received from 16 sources not anticipated in the budget and from revenues received from anticipated sources 17 in excess of budget estimates in the School Current Expense Fund as follows: 18 19 Federal, State, and Local Unrestricted Funds 20 \$ 4,228,826 21 \$ Federal, State, and Local Restricted Grant Funds 4,019,800 22 23 Unappropriated fund balance for the Internal Service Fund for 24 Health Care (Restricted Funds) \$ 10,338,500 25 26 SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal 27 year ending June 30, 2025, is hereby amended by transferring funds from the below-listed 28 accounts in the School Current Expense Fund in the respective amounts set forth: 29 30 \$ 31 (1) Administration 515.900 \$ 2,011,800 (2) Other Instructional Costs 32 \$ (3) Health Services 333,300 33 \$ (4) Pupil Transportation 34 1,840,700 (5) Maintenance of Plant \$ 278,000 35 36 SECTION 3. And be it further enacted, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal 37 year ending June 30, 2025, is hereby amended by making supplementary appropriations of 38 such funds and by transferring such funds as enumerated in Sections 1 and 2 of this 39 Ordinance to the below-listed accounts in the School Current Expense Fund in the 40 respective amounts set forth: 41 42 (1) Mid-Level Administration \$ 2,864,190 43 \$ (2) Instructional Salaries and Wages 3,473,800 44 \$ (3) Textbooks and Classroom Supplies 1,505,900 45 \$ (4) Special Education 689,300 46 \$ (5) Pupil Services 56,300 47 \$ (6) Operation of Plant 2,197,089 48

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6 SECTION 4. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an 7 emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, 8 health, safety, welfare, and property, and being passed by the affirmative vote of five 9 members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
