10	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,
11	That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

13	ARTICLE 4. FINANCE, TAXATION, AND BUDGET

15	TITLE 6. TAXES ON SERVICES AND COMMODITIES

17	4-6-106. Parking lot and garage tax.
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19	(c) Amount of tax. There is levied on the privilege of parking a motor vehicle in a
20	garage or on a parking lot in the County a tax of [[\$0.60]] \$1.00 for each motor vehicle
21	parked for each 24-hour period or fraction of a 24-hour period. If a motor vehicle is parked

garage or on a parking lot in the County a tax of [[\$0.60]] \$1.00 for each motor vehicle parked for each 24-hour period or fraction of a 24-hour period. If a motor vehicle is parked in a garage or on a parking lot for which a charge is made on a weekly or monthly basis, or on some basis other than a 24-hour period, the amount of tax shall be computed by multiplying [[\$0.60]] \$1.00 by the total number of days in the period of time for which the charge is made.
