12	SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,

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23	(c) Capital facility recoupment charge.

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[[July 1, 2024]] JULY 1, 2025. 2 3 (2) for the fiscal year beginning [[July 1, 2025]] JULY 1, 2026, and for each fiscal 4 year thereafter, the County Executive shall set the capital facility recoupment charge for 5 6 connections to the County's water system in accordance with § 4-11-105 of this Code and may increase the charge in an amount not to exceed 5.00% of the then current charge. Any 7 increase in the charge in an amount greater than 5.00% shall be set by the County Council 8 9 by Ordinance. 10 (3) Any residential customer whose water usage exceeds 30,000 gallons in any 11 12 billing quarter shall be charged, in addition to the usage charges in subsection (b), the capital facility recoupment charge for every full 1,000 gallons of water used in excess of 13 30,000 gallons. 14 15 *** 16 17 13-5-813. (s) Development applications submitted prior to June 1, 2019. For a property for 1 2 which an application for approval of a building permit, sketch plan, final plan, preliminary plan, or site development plan was submitted to the Office of Planning and Zoning prior to 3 June 1, 2019, or for which an allocation was granted prior to June 1, 2019, the capital 4 facility connection charge shall be \$7,202 for connections to the County's water system 5 6 and \$7,202 for connections to the County's wastewater system. The rates in this subsection shall increase by 2.5% on July 1 of each year [[from]] BEGINNING IN 2020 [[through 2022 7 and beginning in 2024]]. 8 9

SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect on July 1,
2025.
