11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
12 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

13 ARTICLE 18. ZONING

14 TITLE 10. REQUIREMENTS FOR CONDITIONAL USES

15 18-10-140. Home occupations.

17 A home occupation shall comply with all of the following requirements.

(XVIII) PET GROOMING PROVIDED THE TOTAL NUMBER OF DOGS OR CATS PERMITTED ON THE PREMISES FOR PURPOSES OF GROOMING SERVICES DOES NOT EXCEED 2 AT ANY TIME UNLESS THE DOGS OR CATS ARE UNDER COMMON OWNERSHIP, AND DOGS ARE KEPT IN A FENCED AREA WITH A SECURE LOCKING GATE WHEN OUTDOORS.

SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
