 Tentative schedule Midsummer





Traffic Operation Enhancements

Creation of No Thru Trucks over 5 Ton

- County will proceed with creating No Thru Trucks for Riedel Road
 - Phase 1 End of October (Completed)
 - Phase 2 Signs on SHA Road
 - Update: Memo and request submitted to SHA D5





- Short term
 - Lower speed limit to 30 mph (Supported by community) 74/35
 - Review existing speed signing placement and adjustment
 - Review existing warning signs
 - <u>Completion by End of November 2024 Completed for Riedel Rd</u>
 - Johns Hopkins Rd Developing speed limit change memo -Completion by end of March.
 - Update Memo completed. Created the Work Orders. Will need to coordinate with County Police for proper implementation.

- Long term
 - Johns Hopkins Rd Evaluate road diet <u>38/62</u>
