- A YOUTH NATURE IMMERSION PROGRAM SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS.
 - (1) THE USE SHALL BE LOCATED ON A LOT OF AT LEAST FIVE ACRES.
 - (2) THE USE SHALL BE LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM OF 60 YOUTH ON-SITE AT ONE TIME.
 - (3) ADEQUATE AND CLEAN SANITARY FACILITIES SHALL BE PROVIDED.
- (4) PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF AREAS SHALL BE ADEQUATE TO PROVIDE CONVENIENT
 ACCESS TO THE SITE WITHOUT OFF-SITE QUEUING OF VEHICLES AND TO PROVIDE SAFE
 INTERIOR CIRCULATION OF VEHICLES AND VISITORS.
- 19 (5) THE ACTIVITIES ON THE SITE SHALL BE LOCATED IN A MANNER TO SHIELD
 20 SURROUNDING RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY FROM THE EFFECTS OF NOISE, HAZARDS, OR
 21 OTHER OFFENSIVE CONDITIONS.

- SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
 from the date it becomes law.
