Cradle to Career

- Pastor Billy has a driving school partner we could connect with
- Youth Sports
 - Is it possible to connect with Rec and Parks to support community sports?
 - Brooklyn Park youth do not have access to the same sports opportunities as youth in other areas do - meaning that they do not have the same opportunities to become skilled players
 - Middle schools are beginning to have sports, are the opportunities for elementary school?
 - Ask school system how to connect
 - Multiple hurdles to jump through for youth sports
 - Field availability, becoming certified by Rec and Parks, and referee availability
 - Idea: train older youth to be referees for younger youth games to add more to the pool





- Idea: Have sports in the off seasons to avoid conflict (example: Basketball in fall rather than winter)
- Is there a potential for splash pads instead of pools?
- There is a soccer field on 10th Avenue that is under utilized
- The Athletic Director at BPMS has the schedule for the BPMS fields

Families are Economically Stable

- Idea: The thrift store will soon be moving, that could be a place for services
- Are there opportunities for online training programs for people to access?
 - Technology/internet access becomes a challenge on an individual level
 - Pastor Billy shared an idea to have trainings with online instructors at a location where people can meet to still create community
 - o Classes should also be in Spanish, and ESOL classes should be offered
- Housing opportunities:
 - ACDS has programming for mortgage assistance
 - It is online via Teams
 - Is there potential for in person in Brooklyn Park?
 - People struggle with the first time home buyer programs, both qualifying and filling out the application
 - St. Vincent de Paul does transitional housing suggestion to buy homes in Brooklyn Park for people
 - Idea: Add an incentive to Family Stability clients with the partnership like a HYSA or a CD
- Technology access:
 - Library has technology but is not accessible for everyone
 - The schools also have technology can they share?
