- Rats
- Safety cameras? Do they record?
  - Question for the police department - Lawrence
- Crimes with things from cars being stolen, lawn mowers being stolen



- Seniors could be a part of neighborhood watches
  - Emergency phones like on college campuses
  - Community watches - low turn out when people try to organize, but also need to be cognizant of “who” is being watched
  - People are not reporting thefts - this makes it difficult to have the data to receive grant funding to address
  - Data from Donna from CURE Violence - Donna will send cost and write up
  - Patapsco Park - there are 13 block captains and who get information out about incidents on the street.
  - Ask Meredith at GBA if she is still interested sidewalks at the community center
  - Talk to Sam about Route 2 and people being stuck on either side - is there possibility for a pedestrian bridge?
