Flourishing Families Match

- National model, Investing in Flourishing, designed to bring missing markets to pay for human services.
- Focus on maternal health
- Expand childcare options
- Create a cohort of 20 families through 2 Gen Family Stability model using intensive case management, family coaching and a building wealth component including adding child care voucher for work purposes - This will be funded by O'Neill foundation
- Expansion of healthy food
- Increase coordination with workforce and career development at the library
- **One of our strategies listed is to use ENOUGH funding as a match for the building wealth component - We need your approval of this**

Overview of Grant Application

End child poverty and increase economic mobility by growing flourishing children from pre-natal care to career inside flourishing families in a flourishing neighborhood

Goals:

- Build on and develop collaborative partnerships across governmental, not for profit and private systems to maximize effort
- Blend and braid funding and resources to ensure a steady flow of financial support
- Ensure residents of Brooklyn park are at the front and center of planning, decision making and evaluation
