A public meeting has been scheduled from 6:00 PM-7:00 PM on Thursday, September 18, 2025 at Marley Elementary School to discuss plans to construct a new shared-use path along the east side of Marley Neck Boulevard from the northern end of the trail at the Creekside development to the sidewalk south of Tanyard Springs Lane.

The purpose of the project is to improve pedestrian and bicyclist connectivity along Marley Neck Boulevard. Retaining walls are proposed where the path crosses over an existing culvert and there will be curb, gutter and pavement replacement to accommodate them.

The project is slated to start in spring 2026 and be finished by fall 2026. The northbound lane of Marley Neck Boulevard will be closed during construction. There will be traffic control devices, including drums, arrow panels and temporary traffic signs to guide motorists and provide a safe work zone for the contractor.

Since the project includes proposed work within the 25-foot wetland buffer, there has been extensive planning and design to ensure there are minimal, temporary wetland impacts during construction.
