The County has made no public progress towards getting the Discovery Village boat ramp back. Discovery Village is for sale. There is \$3.1 million in the county FY26 Boat Ramp Development account and no new county public boat ramp in progress. The County must use the \$3.1 million in the boat ramp account and buy Discovery Village. The County can seek state funds, such as the Waterway Improvement Fund and Program Open Space, to leverage the \$3.1 million in the county boat ramp account and assemble a funding package for the acquisition and rehabilitation of Discovery Village into the Discovery Village Public Boating and Community Center. There is an important state funding deadline this week. The deadline for Waterway Improvement Fund (WIF) grants is Thursday, September 18, 2025 before midnight. The county can use the simple WIF application to document the total funding need for Discovery Village. The Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR) can then analyze Discovery Village determine what DNR funding sources may be available. I urge the County apply for WIF funding by the Thursday deadline. An acquisition of Discovery Village would not only regain the Discovery Village boat ramp, it would also be the site of the Community Center long sought by South County.
