1	RESOLUTION approving the designation of certain areas near the Glen Burnie
2	(Cromwell) Light Raillink Station as a transit-oriented development
3	
4	WHEREAS, § 7-101(p)(1) and (2) of the Transportation Article of the State Code
5	provide that a "transit-oriented development" is a mix of public and private parking
6	facilities, commercial and residential structures, and other uses and improvements
7	that is part of a deliberate development strategy for property that is adjacent to or
8	any part of which is within a one-half mile radius of the passenger boarding area of
9	a transit station or is adjacent to a transit corridor, and that is planned to maximize
10	the use of transit, walking, and bicycling by residents and employees; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, § 7-101(p)(3) further provides the transit-oriented development area
13	must be designated by the Sustainable Growth Subcabinet and the local government
14	with land use and planning responsibility for the area that is applying for the
15	designation; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the County Office of Planning and Zoning has designated an area near
18	the Glen Burnie (Cromwell) Light Raillink Station, as shown on Exhibit A, attached
19	hereto, that meets the requirements of § 7-101(p) (the "Site"); and
20	
21	WHEREAS, designation of a transit-oriented development by the State makes the
22	site eligible for benefits through various State programs; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, Plan2040 (the County's general development plan), the Region 1
25	Plan, and the County's Transit-Oriented Development Feasibility Study identified
26	the site as a potential location for a transit-oriented development, which could result
27	in a mixed use residential and commercial area that provides safe walkability and
28	connectivity to the Glen Burnie Town Center and the B & A Trail; and

30	WHEREAS, the County Executive has approved this designation and is requesting
31	that the County Council confirm this action, as required by Section 1014 of the
32	Charter; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it hereby confirms the County Executive's approval of the designation of the site near the Glen

Burnie (Cromwell) Light Raillink Station, as shown on Exhibit A, as a transit-oriented

development, within the meaning of § 7-101(p) of the Transportation Article of the State
