A public meeting has been scheduled from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 18, 2025 at the Glen Burnie Library to discuss construction of a new two-story building to replace the existing Glen Burnie Library branch. The new building will include a lab and offices for the Office of Planning and Zoning's Cultural Resources Section. The new library will also include spaces for all ages, a fenced-in rear green space, community meeting spaces, and other amenities. The Cultural Resources Section will house artifacts, a research library, and an archeological lab.

The new facility would be constructed at the same site as the current library, which will be demolished. Once the current building is removed, work on the new one will begin. During construction, the County will use a rented facility for the library.

Construction hours would 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. No major road impacts are expected.
