Trip FAQs

- Payments must be made by cash or check, only.
 - Make checks payable to “P.S.I.”
- Deposits are required at the time of registration for overnight trips.
 - Deposit amount varies depending on the trip (\$25-\$100)
- A current valid **government issued ID** is **required**.
- A current senior activity center **member key tag number** is **required**.
- All trip balances must be paid in full 60 days prior to the trip date. PSI is NOT responsible for trip/balance payment reminders.
- **NO refunds** will be issued for personal cancellations.
 - The participant is responsible to fill the trip seat, otherwise the balance or funds will be lost.
- Ask the trip coordinator about accessibility accommodations for each trip.
 - Anyone needing the assistance of a caregiver may have one accompany them. Caregivers must register and pay, just like all other trip participants.
 - Trip leaders and participants cannot provide any physical assistance.
