## PUBLIC MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT

WHAT: Water Main Extension - St. Margarets Road/Old Mill Bottom Road Project# - W801201

WHEN: Monday, November 17, 2025 - 6:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

WHERE: Broadneck Library

A public meeting has been scheduled from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Monday, November 17, 2025 at the Broadneck Library to discuss plans to install a new water main, including a new hydrant and water meter service, for 1717, 1730 and 1735 St. Margarets Road. The proposed improvements will improve the connectivity of the water system to provide greater reliability and extend water service and fire protection to several residences.

Construction will take place about 400 feet on each side of the St. Margarets Road Bridge at Mill Creek, beginning in early spring 2026 and finishing in summer 2026. Work in the roadway will require the closure of the southbound lane of St. Margarets, and a detour will be in place for two-to-three weeks. The rest of the construction will involve a flagger operation during work hours only. Residents will be notified at least two days prior to all construction activities via door hangers.

A temporary water service interruption will occur for about 17 residents in the area over an eight-hour period on one day. Residents will be notified 48 hours beforehand.
