SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

FISCAL IMPACT

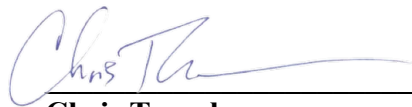
Operating Budget – Personal Services: No effect.

Operating Budget – Other Operating Costs: No effect. The property proposed to be declared surplus and transferred is approximately 2,509 square feet, which is 6/100 of one acre. Any savings in maintenance or other costs would be negligible.

Revenues: No effect. The Resolution approves the disposition of the property for zero dollars of consideration.
