Apple Crisp:

6 cups sliced cooking apples (Idea Note: Try mixing Granny Smith with Golden Delicious)

1 cup Sugar

1 tsp. Baking Powder

3/4 tsp. salt

l egg (unbeaten)

I stick of melted butter

1 tsp. cinnamon

Place sliced apples in 10 inch baking dish.

For the topping:

In a separate bowl combine flour, sugar, baking powder, salt and egg.

Mix till blended. Spread the topping mixture over the apples.

Pour melted butter over the topping, and sprinkle with the cinnamon.

Bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes.
