(2) The Administrative Officer to the County Council shall be responsible for evaluating County Council staff that report to the Administrative Officer of the County Council, but not the Legislative Counsel or Legislative Aides.

2-102. Administrative Officer; Assistant Administrative Officer.

 (a) **Generally.** There are an Administrative Officer to the County Council and an Assistant Administrative Officer to the County Council. THE ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER SHALL REPORT TO AND BE SUPERVISED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER.
