1 RESOLUTION amending portions of Title 2 of the Rules of Procedure of the County  
2 Council

4 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 208(g) of the Charter, the County Council is  
5 required to adopt rules of procedure; and

6  
7 WHEREAS, Section 1-103 of these Rules of Procedure provides that the County  
8 Council may amend the Rules by resolution provided the amendment is submitted  
9 in writing to the County Council at least seven days before the action on the  
10 resolution; now, therefore, be it

12 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That Section(s)*  
13 *2-101(b) and 2-102(a) of the Rules of Procedure of the County Council of Anne Arundel*  
14 *County (June, 2025) read as follows:*

16 **TITLE 2. OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES**

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18 **2-101. Supervision of employees.**

22 (1) (i) The Administrative Officer to the County Council and the Legislative Counsel  
23 shall be subject to an annual evaluation prepared by the Chair of the County Council and  
24 one member of the County Council from a different political party.

26 (ii) The Deputy/Assistant Administrative Officer to the County Council shall  
27 REPORT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER WHO SHALL PREPARE ~~[[be subject to]]~~ an  
28 annual evaluation ~~[[prepared by the Administrative Officer,]]~~ FOR the Chair of the County  
29 Council and one member of the County Council from a different political party.

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31 (iii) Annual reviews shall be based on input from each member of the County  
32 Council, and each member of the County Council may review and comment on the  
33 evaluation before it is finalized.

1       (2) The Administrative Officer to the County Council shall be responsible for  
2       evaluating County Council staff that report to the Administrative Officer of the County  
3       Council, but not the Legislative Counsel or Legislative Aides.

5       **2-102. Administrative Officer; Assistant Administrative Officer.**

7       (a) **Generally.** There are an Administrative Officer to the County Council and an  
8       Assistant Administrative Officer to the County Council. THE ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATIVE  
9       OFFICER SHALL REPORT TO AND BE SUPERVISED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER.
