## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Capital Budget and Program – Board of Education Security  
2 Related Upgrades and Upgrade Various Schools capital projects – Supplementary  
3 Appropriations

4  
5 FOR the purpose of amending the Capital Budget for the current fiscal year by making a  
6 supplementary appropriation of funds to the Board of Education Security Related  
7 Upgrades and Upgrade Various Schools capital projects; amending the Capital  
8 Program and Capital Projects Bond Ordinance for the current fiscal year; and generally  
9 relating to appropriations of funds in projects in the Capital Budget for the fiscal year  
10 ending June 30, 2026.

16 WHEREAS, the Board of Education Security Related Upgrades capital project  
17 (Project No. E538100) and Upgrade Various Schools capital project (Project No.  
18 E539100) have existing appropriations in the Capital Budget for the fiscal year  
19 ending June 30, 2026; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, Section 716 of the Charter authorizes the County Council, upon  
22 request of the County Executive and by affirmative vote of five members of the  
23 County Council, to amend the Capital Budget; and

24  
25 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 716 of the Charter, upon recommendation of the  
26 County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations to  
27 the Capital Budget from revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess

1 of budget estimates therefor, or from revenues received from sources not  
2 anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year; and

4 WHEREAS, additional grant funding in the total amount of \$990,727 has become  
5 available for the Board of Education Security Related Upgrades capital project from  
6 the State Interagency Commission on School Construction and the State  
7 Department of Education, which is from a source anticipated in the budget, but in  
8 excess of budget estimates therefor; and

9  
10 WHEREAS, additional funding in the total amount of \$238,873 has become  
11 available for the Upgrade Various Schools capital project from miscellaneous  
12 revenue from Constellation Energy Foundation, Arundel High School, and R.C.S.  
13 Plumbing, LLC; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, the County Executive is requesting that the Capital Budget be  
16 amended by making a supplementary appropriation to the Board of Education  
17 Security Related Upgrades capital project (Project No. E538100) and to the  
18 Upgrade Various Schools capital project (Project No. E539100); and

19  
20 WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Charter, the Planning Advisory  
21 Board has recommended these amendments to the Capital Budget; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, the Controller has certified in writing that the funds are available for  
24 appropriation; now, therefore,

25  
26 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
27 That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, is hereby  
28 amended by making supplementary appropriations to the following capital projects as  
29 follows:

31 Security Related Upgrades capital project (Project No. E538100) \$ 990,727  
32 (Other State Grants)

34 Upgrade Various Schools capital project (Project No. E539100) \$ 238,873  
35 (Miscellaneous)

37 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, that the Capital Program and the Capital  
38 Projects Bond Ordinance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, are hereby amended in  
39 accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance.

41 SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect from the  
42 date it becomes law.
