# S002427 - North County Sewer Diversions

**Project Description:** This project will provide for design, land acquisition, construction, and inspection of collection and conveyance system modifications and upgrades needed to support the relief of potential capacity issues in the Baltimore City Service Area.

**FY27 Request:** \$ 6.5 Million

**FY28 Request:** \$ 50.4 Million


**Total Project Cost:** \$ 56.9 Million

**Benefit:** The project will support development in alignment with current zoning and General Development Plan.

**Reason for Project:** The intent of the project is to provide capacity relief to end the current moratorium on new connections in the Baltimore City Sewer Service Area that went into effect on March 2, 2026. Anne Arundel County has reached peak flow capacity limitations in the Baltimore City Sewer Service Area (SSA), specifically where it connects to the Baltimore County Patapsco Interceptor and Sewage Pumping Station (SPS). Ongoing consent decrees prevent Baltimore City and Baltimore County from allocating additional capacity, creating a bottleneck for new development and requiring immediate action.




## Strategic Diversion Plan

- North County Wastewater Strategic Plan to evaluate at least 5 diversion alternatives to send flow to Patuxent SSA, and/or Cox Creek SSA (S776712)
- Plan will be completed in 8 months

## Design/Construction of Flow Diversions

- Estimated 4-5 Years
- Cost estimates will be determined from the Strategic Diversion Plan
