1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Boards, Commissions, and Similar Bodies – Resilience
2 Authority of Annapolis and Anne Arundel County – Membership – Director

4 FOR the purpose of removing certain requirements for membership of the Resilience
5 Authority; revising the process for appointment of the Director of the Resilience
6 Authority; and generally relating to boards, commissions, and similar bodies.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: §§ 3-18-103(a)(1); and 3-18-107(a)

10 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

12 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*
13 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

14 15 **ARTICLE 3. BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND SIMILAR BODIES**

16 17 **TITLE 18. RESILIENCE AUTHORITY OF ANNAPOLIS** 18 **AND ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY**

19 20 **3-18-103. Membership.**

21 22 **(a) Composition.**

24 (1) The Resilience Authority consists of twelve members appointed as follows:

1 (i) Nine members shall be [[residents of the County]] appointed by the County
2 Executive; and

4 (ii) Three members shall be [[residents of the City of Annapolis]] appointed by
5 the Mayor OF THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS.

7 **3-18-107. Resilience Authority Director.**

9 (a) **Appointment.**

10
11 (1) The [[County Executive, with the concurrence of the Mayor of the City of
12 Annapolis, shall appoint the first Resilience Authority Director.

13
14 (2) Any subsequent]] Resilience Authority Director shall be appointed by the
15 [[County Executive]] AUTHORITY'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS, after advice and
16 recommendation by [[members of the Resilience Authority and with the concurrence of]]
17 the COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND Mayor of the City of Annapolis.

19 ~~[[3]]~~ (2) The Resilience Authority Director shall be an employee of the Resilience
20 Authority and shall serve at the pleasure of the [[County Executive]] AUTHORITY'S BOARD
21 OF DIRECTORS.

23 (b) **Qualifications.** The Resilience Authority Director shall be of good character,
24 integrity, and business experience, and shall meet all requirements of a job description
25 developed by the [[County Executive with the concurrence of the Mayor of the City of
26 Annapolis]] AUTHORITY'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

28 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
29 from the date it becomes law.
