FISCAL NOTE

BILL: Public Ethics – Definitions – Campaign Contributions – 2 Subdivision and Development – Mandatory Disclosures

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

This bill prohibits a County Executive, County Councilmember, or candidates for those offices from accepting campaign contributions exceeding \$250 per election cycle from specified individuals who are connected to pending zoning and development applications. It also requires applicants to disclose certain contributions made within two years prior, or any time subsequent to the application.

FISCAL IMPACT


Operating Budget – Personal Services: No effect. The County Ethics Commission anticipates that it can manage these requirements with existing staff.
