PUBLIC DEMONSTRATION OF THE VOTING SYSTEM

In accordance with the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR), Title 33.10.01.16, at **9:00 a.m.** on **Thursday, May 28, 2026**, the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections will conduct the pre-election public demonstration of the voting units to be used for the June 23, 2026 Gubernatorial Primary Election. The public will be allowed to inspect the printouts of results from the pre-election logic and accuracy testing. The public demonstration will be conducted at the Anne Arundel County Board of Elections office located at 6740 Baymeadow Drive, Glen Burnie, Maryland, 21060. Following the Public Demonstration of the Voting System, the Board shall conduct the Early Voting and Election Day Supply Verification.
