The Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works (DPW) would like to inform you about a Capital Improvement Project in your area. This project is part of the County's ongoing efforts to maintain and improve critical infrastructure that supports safe, reliable and sustainable communities.

About the Project

The project involves constructing a missing 250-foot-long segment of sidewalk along Quarterfield Road from north of Severn Pines Way to south of Colonial Park Drive. This includes widening the roadway in that area to maintain a consistent paved shoulder, as well as curb and drainage improvements.

Construction is expected to begin in spring 2027 and take about a month. Work hours will be 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on weekdays. One lane will be closed on Quarterfield Road during construction and flaggers will direct motorists through the area.
