Charter Amendment – Council Officers

RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the Charter of Anne Arundel County to remove specific position titles from the officers appointed by the Council

*Be it resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the following amendment to the Anne Arundel County Charter is proposed for submission to the qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2026:*

**Article III. The Legislative Branch**

**Sec. 302. Officers.**

\*\*\*

**(b) Other Officers and Duties.** ~~[[There shall be an Administrative Officer to the County Council, appointed by the County Council, who shall keep minutes of its meetings and maintain its Journal. There may be]]~~ THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY PROVIDE FOR THE SELECTION OF such other officers AND EMPLOYEES of the County Council as may be provided in its Rules of Procedure. Officers of the Council shall perform duties and functions not inconsistent with those assigned to the legislative branch by this Charter or the Rules of Procedure of the Council.

*And be it further resolved, That the following question is adopted for submittal to the qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2026 for their adoption or rejection:*

“To amend the Anne Arundel County Charter to remove specific position titles from the officers appointed by the Council.”

*And be it further resolved, That this question shall be designated as Question “\_\_” on the ballot at the General Election in November 2026.*

1        *And be it further resolved*, That if the majority of qualified votes cast in the election  
2 are for the Charter Amendment, this amendment shall stand adopted from and after the 30<sup>th</sup>  
3 day following the election.
