Subject: Resolution No. 17-26 – RESOLUTION approving appointments to the Board of Trustees for the Anne Arundel County Retirement and Pension System

This summary was prepared by the Anne Arundel County Government Relations Office for use by members of the Anne Arundel County Council during consideration of Resolution No. 17-26.

Summary

This Resolution, introduced at the request of the Administration, reappoints three members to the Board of Trustees for the Anne Arundel County Retirement and Pension System. Anne Arundel County Code § 5-2-104 provides that there is a Board of Trustees for the Anne Arundel County Retirement and Pension System. Section 5-2-105(a)(7) provides that three of the Trustees shall be residents of the County, may not be employees of the County, may not be participants in any of the retirement or pension plans governed by the Board of Trustees, and shall be knowledgeable in the administration and operation of pension systems and trust funds, and who shall be appointed by the County Executive with the approval of the County Council, given by resolution, pursuant to § 5-2-105(c). The terms of the trustees are three years, as provided in § 5-2-105(e). The current trustees are serving as holdovers since the expiration of their most recent terms and all wish to continue serving on the Board.

Mary Lu Hughes completed a term as one of the three Trustees described in §5-2-105(a)(7) on April 30, 2023, and has continued to serve and is reappointed to a term beginning on May 1, 2026, and expiring on April 30, 2029. Mary Kathleen Sulick completed a term as one of the three Trustees described in § 5-2-105(a)(7) on April 30, 2024, and is reappointed to the remainder of a term expiring April 30, 2027, and Alan J. Hyatt is reappointed for the remainder of a term expiring on December 1, 2027.

Note: This Legislative and Fiscal Summary provides a synopsis of the legislation as introduced. It does not address subsequent amendments to the legislation.

Purpose

The purpose of this Resolution is to reappoint Mary Lu Hughes, Mary Kathleen Sulick, and Alan J. Hyatt to the remainder of staggered terms to serve on the Board of Trustees for the Retirement and Pension System for Anne Arundel County.

Fiscal Impact

As this is a resolution reappointing three members to a Board for which they receive no compensation, there is no fiscal impact.
