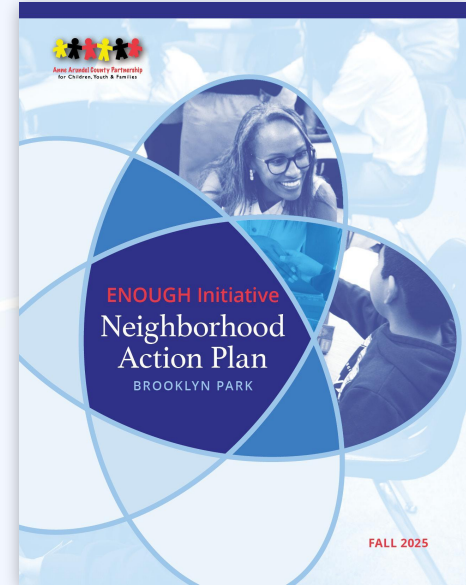

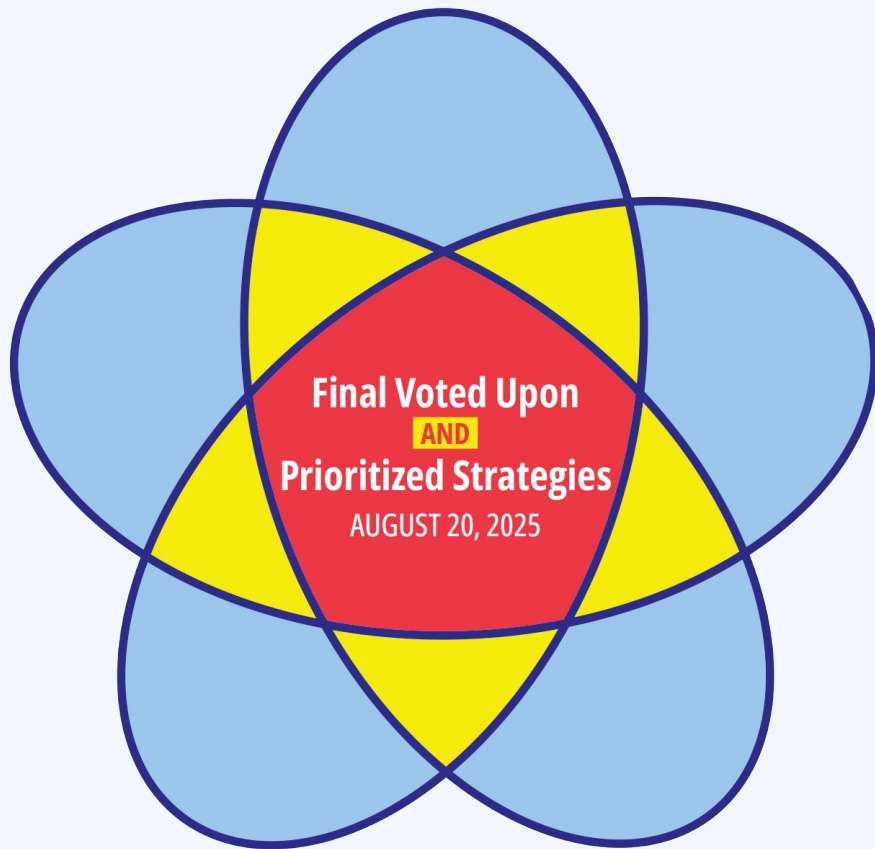

Jobs for the Future Update

- Provided labor market data that will drive the Workforce Committee & presented last month to Leadership team
- Findings found health care were the highest needs in 21225 - Medstar and Hammonds Lane Nursing Facility were among the biggest employers
- JFF will convene the first Workforce Committee - date to be determined



Enterprise Update

- Completed first workshop for Housing and Education needs assessment - completed survey from partners
- Did a Brooklyn Park tour
- Next workshop is September 9
- Goal is to focus on the intersection between housing and education
- Jen Lacque (AACPS PPW for homeless students) will join committee



Workforce Committee

- Create a through line for cradle to career, engaging education and career development experts to increase the likelihood of a liveable wage
- This will inform Year 3 priorities for additional programming
