A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Supplementary Appropriations
2 – Chief Administrative Office – Technical Corrections of Annual Budget and
3 Appropriation Ordinance

5 FOR the purpose of making supplementary appropriations from contingent funds in the
6 general fund of the County for the current fiscal year; making certain technical
7 corrections to the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance to align with changes
8 made through amendments to the Ordinance; and generally relating to making
9 supplementary appropriations to the Current Expense Budget and the Annual Budget
10 and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027.

12 BY amending: Current Expense Budget
13 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, Bill No. 32-26, Section
14 49 and Exhibit A, Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2026

16 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the
17 County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary and emergency
18 appropriations from contingent funds, provided that the Controller shall first certify
19 in writing that such funds are available for appropriation; and

21 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended a supplementary
22 appropriation of contingent funds to the Chief Administrative Office in the Current
23 Expense Budget, and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are
24 available for appropriation; and

26 WHEREAS, the County Council amended and passed the County's Annual Budget
27 and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, Bill

No. 32-26 (the “ABAO”), on June 11, 2026, and the ABAO became effective on July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the ABAO listed an existing capital project in the wrong category in Section 49 of the ABAO; and

WHEREAS, certain amendments to the ABAO made changes to the ABAO, however, corresponding changes were not made to Exhibit A to the ABAO; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, is hereby amended by making a supplementary appropriation from contingent funds as follows:

Chief Administrative Office – General Fund Appropriation	
Contingency	
Grants, Contributions & Other	\$ 142,500

and by adding such funds to the below-listed department in the amount set forth:

Chief Administrative Office – General Fund Appropriation	
Management & Control	
Grants, Contributions & Other	\$ 142,500

SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2027, Bill No. 32-26, Section 49 and Exhibit A, Laws of Anne Arundel County, 2026, is hereby amended as follows.

Bill No. 32-26
Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance

a. On page 12 of the Ordinance, in Section 49, in the list under Subsection “A.”, below the row beginning “Gen Co Project Plan”, insert the following row:

<u>“Information Technology Enhance</u>	<u>\$2,832,000”</u> ; and
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in Section 49, in the list under Subsection “C.”, strike the row beginning “Information Technology Enhance” in its entirety.

b. In Exhibit A to the Ordinance, on page 1, in line 18, strike “1,054,413,100”, and substitute “1,054,948,500”.

c. In Exhibit A to the Ordinance, on page 4, in line 26, strike “318,300”, and substitute “518,300”.

SECTION 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
